Your Excellency,

Nigerian national Suliamon Olufemi faces execution in Saudi Arabia after being sentenced to death in 2005 in connection with the death of a police officer. He received an unfair trial during which he did not, for example, have access to adequate translation or interpreting services. Suliamon Olufemi and some of the other co-defendants have reported being tortured or ill-treated during interrogations.

I am very concerned about Suliamon Olufemi, which is why I respectfully ask you to quash his conviction and order a retrial in line with international fair trial standards and without recourse to the death penalty.

I also call on you to order an independent investigation into the allegations of torture and other ill-treatment.

Lastly, please grant Suliamon Olufemi regular access to a lawyer of his choice.
